PROJECT A

Review of a television show/ web series. (500 words)

The composition may be structured in the following manner:

1. Start with a **Brief Overview**: Begin the review with a concise summary of the show's premise, genre, and any relevant background information about the production, creators, or source material.
2. Evaluate the **Plot and Storyline**: Assess the series' plot progression and coherence. Mention if the story is engaging and well-structured or if it suffers from inconsistencies or plot holes.
3. Analyze the **Characters**: Evaluate the main and supporting characters' development, complexity, and relevance to the overall narrative. Discuss the performances of the actors portraying these roles.
4. Comment on **Production Values**: Assess the production quality, including cinematography, set design, costumes, special effects, and soundtrack. Determine how well these elements contribute to the show's atmosphere and storytelling.
5. Discuss **Themes and Messages**: Identify any prominent theme or underlying message(s) conveyed by the series. Explore how effectively these themes are explored and conveyed throughout the episodes.
6. **Compare with Similar Series**: If relevant, compare the show with similar TV series in the same genre or with similar themes.
7. **Be Objective**: While expressing personal opinions, strive to be objective and support your statements with evidence from the series. Acknowledge any strengths and weaknesses the show may have.
8. **Provide Recommendations**: Conclude the review by summarizing your overall thoughts on the series. Recommend the show to specific audiences or highlight who might enjoy it the most.

Order to be maintained:

1. The first page should have your Name, Class, Section, Roll Number and the Subject name. Your ISC UID number will be added later.

After this, you must follow the order of the outline of the project as mentioned above. Please note that different topic headings should be mentioned for different points. You will end the project with a Bibliography (List the references that helped you write this review. If you have taken help from any website, then mention the hyperlink, instead of just writing google.com. Mention the name of the streaming platform where you watched the web series)

Things to remember:

-The project file will be covered with brown paper. Stick a label with your name, class, section, roll

number. Leave space for adding your ISC UID number.

-Add a contextual cover picture on the front cover of the project.

-From introduction to conclusion, add 2-3/3-4 coloured photographs and/or original art work depending upon the size you choose. Photographs are to be bordered and labeled with a black pen.

-Black ink is to be used for writing. You can be creative with labels and titles, but for this skip colors like green and red.

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PROJECT B
